

honeycomb scarf for kids

Materials: One skein (ball) of any yarn. The bulkier your yarn, the 'fatter' your scarf will be.
I used 3/4 ball of Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino which is 5ply/ sportweight.

Gauge : Does not matter! :)

Needles : Use the size recommended on the yarn label.

You will need a Cable Needle as well as a stitch holder.

Abbrev : **Garter st** Knit all rows **Inc 1** Pick up the loop between the two sts with left hand needle from front to back and knit through back loop with right hand needle **SSK** Slip Slip Knit **K2tog** Knit two together **Sl2B** Slip 2 sts on to Cable Needle and hold at back **Sl1F** Slip 1 st on to Cable Needle and hold at front **CN** Cable Needle.

Cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (and all RS rows): K1, Inc 1, K to last st, Inc 1, K1,

Row 2 : Knit

Repeat rows 1 and 2 (garter st) until you have 28 sts and completed a WS row.

Start Main Honeycomb Pattern:

*The first and last two sts are always knitted on every row to create a selvedge.

Rows 1 and 3: K2, P2 (K2, P4) thrice, K2, P2, K2

Rows 2 and all even rows: K2, K the Knit sts and P the Purl sts as they face you.
End K2.

Row 5 : K2, (Sl2B, K1, P2 from CN, Sl1F, P2, K1 from CN) repeat () to last 2 sts, K2.

Rows 7 and 9: K3, (P4, K2) repeat () to last st, K1.

Row 11 :K2, (Sl1F, P2, K1 from CN, Sl2B, K1, P2 from CN) repeat () to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 12 : Work as row 2.

These 12 rows form the Honeycomb pattern. Repeat until piece measures approx. 43cm, ending with the 12th row.

Next row (RS): (K1, Slip 1 to stitch holder), repeat () until all stitches are used up. You should have 14 sts on your needle and 14 on the holder.

Next row (WS): K

For this section, selvedge will be 1 knitted st instead of 2.

Rows 1 and 3 :K1, P2, K2, P4, K2, P2, K1

Row 2 and all even rows: K1, K the Knit sts and P the Purl sts as they face you.

Row 5 : K1, (Sl2B, K1, P2 from CN, Sl1F, P2, K1 from CN) twice, end K1.

Rows 7 and 9 : K2, (P4, K2) repeat () till end.

Row 11 : K1, (Sl1F, P2, K1 from CN, Sl2B, K1, P2 from CN) twice, end K1

Row 12 : Work as row 2.

Repeat these for 5cm (it can be less than 12 rows), and place the stitches on a holder. Work the other 14 stitches in same manner till it's the same length as the first.

Put the 2 pieces back together by knitting one st from the needle and one st from the holder. If you end with a WS row, knit 1 row. Continue in Main Honeycomb Pattern for 6cm.

Now decrease while working in garter st:

Next row (RS): K1, SSK, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next row: Knit.

Repeat last two rows until 4 sts left. Cast off. Weave in ends and block your scarf!

It should measure approx 60cm.
